This project was completed mid-2011 and had a soft opening in August with an up and coming Grand Opening scheduled for November 27, 2011. The hotel has been enjoying good room occupancy since she opened her doors.

Qingdao is a coastal city, East China's Shandong Province and was the venue for the 2008 Olympic Regatta. Our design inspiration comes from the sails of boats as Qingdao is also fondly called the sailing city in China. Our conceptual design to the Client was to give the hotel a theme that represents the highlights of the city and all hotel clients a memorable visual experience.

Extending the city's highlights, we took the Qingdao city flower, Camellia into the ballroom where they are conceptualized into crystal chandeliers giving this space the grandeur for all their events and functions.

Their rooms are given a fresh, comfortable and relaxing ambiance with custom designed wall panel fabric and carpet for all rooms.



The high ceiling at the Lobby Lounge gave us the opportunity to interpret the design of raised-sails from ceiling to floor. To keep the openness of the space, metal mesh material were used and to add glamour it was studded with 20000 crystal beads and these beads glitter as they reflect the surrounding lights. In the layout of the Lounge, these sails create part of the seating clusters.




CHRISTMAS CARD DESIGN COMPETITION 2011
